
For thousands of years, wolves and Homo sapiens were arch-rivals because they competed for the same food resources. However, weaker wolves may have begun hovering near human settlements to pick at the remains of hunted animals or discarded leftovers. At first, humans would not have trusted these former enemies, but over time, these wolves must have shown affection and a non-threatening attitude toward humans. Eventually, some humans began breeding the friendlier and less aggressive wolves, resulting in a group that gradually became domesticated.



Over time, these wolves adapted—both behaviorally and biologically—becoming gentler, more social, and more responsive to human cues. This gradual process of domestication gave rise to the dog, the first species ever domesticated by humankind. Unlike livestock, which were tamed for utility, dogs were unique: they were companions, protectors, and partners in survival.

The impact of this alliance on the fate of Homo sapiens cannot be overstated. Dogs sharpened human hunting efficiency, guarded camps from predators, and later served as herders, guides, and even healers of loneliness. In evolutionary terms, they amplified human success. Had early humans never welcomed dogs, our ancestors would have faced the wilderness with diminished security and reduced chances of survival. Nights around the fire would have been longer, colder, and more dangerous. Hunting expeditions would have been less productive, and perhaps Homo sapiens might have remained more vulnerable to rival species like the Neanderthals, who also roamed the Earth. 
Workshop


OUR ACHIEVEMENTS
